

For All Poster Presenters in FJS-2025,

Please follow the guidelines below for the poster presentation:

- The Poster venue is a 1st floor of Sakura Hall.
- We will provide poster boards approximately **1,600 mm (height) × 900 mm (width)**. Please ensure your poster fits within this size. We recommend preparing your poster in **A0 size (1,190 mm height × 841 mm width)**.
- The poster boards will be set up on the **Sunday, May 18 (updated on May 12)**. Please attach your poster to the board with your poster number before the poster session begins (the layout is currently under consideration; pushpins will be provided by the secretariat). Please note that **the boards will be removed after 12:00 (updated on May 12) on Tuesday, May 20, so be sure to take down your poster by then**. Any posters left behind will be collected by the secretariat.
- The poster discussion time is **55 minutes**. After the Short Oral Presentation (16:50–18:10), presenters with **odd-numbered posters** will present starting at **18:10**, and presenters with **even-numbered posters** will present starting at **19:05**.

For Poster Presenters with Short Oral Presentation,

Please follow the guidelines below for the Short Oral Presentation:

- The Short Oral Presentation will start from **16:50**, May 19 (Mon.) at Lecture Room.
- Presenters whose turn is coming up next should take a seat in the next-presenter's seat located to the right of the venue screen. Please refer to the abstract booklet for the presentation order.
- You have **2 minutes for presentation time**. A bell will sound at **1.5 minutes (once) and at 2 minutes (twice)** to signal the time. You can check the remaining time on the timer located at the front of you. If you exceed the time, the presentation slide will be moved into that of next presenter.
- We will not give any introduction of your presentation title, name, and affiliation. Please start your presentation when your presentation slide is shown.
- All presentations will be controlled by the conference staff, so you will not be using your own device and the Presenter View will not be available during the session.
- Laser pointers will be provided by the organizing committee during the short oral presentation.
